

BSRBR-RA Outreach/Remote Consent for <u>Re-Registrations</u>



An existing study participant may be eligible for re-registration if they commence treatment with another therapy. The 'eligibility checker' here shows which therapies are eligible for re-registration <u>https://www.bsrbr.org/hospitals/data-collection/</u>. A DAS28 is required from before the commencement of the new therapy.

Step One

Person taking consent posts the documents for outreach consent for re-registration to the study participant:

If the participant has any questions about re-consenting, they can contact the research team on the details provided within the letter.



Step Two

Study participant signs the re-consent form and posts it back to the hospital, along with the HAQ and EQ5D.



Step Four

Study participant can be reregistered in the online database after a <u>switch request</u> has been made in the original Study ID. Please remember to upload the re-consent form.





Step Three

Person taking consent countersigns the re-consent form, posts a copy back to the participant and puts original form in the patient notes.

Top Tips!

 If you don't have a DAS-28 for when the participant started therapy, use the closest pre-biologic score from the patient notes.
If you need stamps for postage, contact the team and we can send you some.
